Program Overview



PURPOSE

School capacity building with a focus on leadership and instruction

PROCESS

- Training and development of K-12 school leadership teams as instructional leaders in five areas:
 1. *Establishing a Culture of Learning*
 2. *Understanding Change*
 3. *Focusing on Quality Instruction and Assessment*
 4. *Building and Sharing Knowledge*
 5. *Developing Coherence through Planning*
- Training takes place at a two-day summer institute and three one-day institutes days spread throughout the year.
- Between institutes, each school team works on an individual job-embedded school assignment and reports its progress to the larger group at each successive institute.

PAYOFF

- Increased leadership, instructional and assessment expertise
- Increased student achievement for all students
- Increased and sustainable school capacity
