



INTRODUCTION

Over the past seventeen years, schools and families have found answers to their educational needs at CDL. Teachers, students and their families work with CDL's licensed and/or certified professionals to understand how their children learn, where the learning process is breaking down, and specific strategies that will help their children.

EVALUATIONS

Evaluations are designed to answer pertinent questions asked by both school personnel and parents. Those performed to determine special education eligibility are compliant with guidelines outlined in the **Louisiana Department of Education Bulletin 1508 Pupil Appraisal Handbook**. The following are examples of evaluation components and related services provided by CDL.

ACT/SAT ACCOMMODATIONS

- Testing procedures mandated by ACT/SAT for extended time, special testing conditions and other accommodations

GIFTED

- Intelligence/Cognition
- Reading Skills
- Math Skills

RELATED SERVICES

► CONSULTATIONS

Consultations are provided to both school personnel and families when students are experiencing problems with academic, emotional or social functioning, and/or behavior.

Consultations may include:

- Functional behavior assessments
- Positive behavioral support plans
- Development of behavioral intervention plans for school and home
- Classroom observations of students followed by recommendations
- Ongoing assistance to school personnel and/or families

► COUNSELING/THERAPY

- Individual and family therapy
- Development of behavior management programs
- Parent training for parental skill building

► ACADEMIC REMEDIATION

Referrals for academic remediation and instruction by qualified professionals are provided as a follow-up service to our evaluation clients.

► CONFERENCE AND MEETING ATTENDANCE

CDL professionals are available to attend school conferences to present evaluation results and/or make recommendations to school personnel.
